Transgender Awareness Week is followed by Transgender Remembrance Day on Monday 20 November, where we remember those who have lost their lives for simply being transgender.

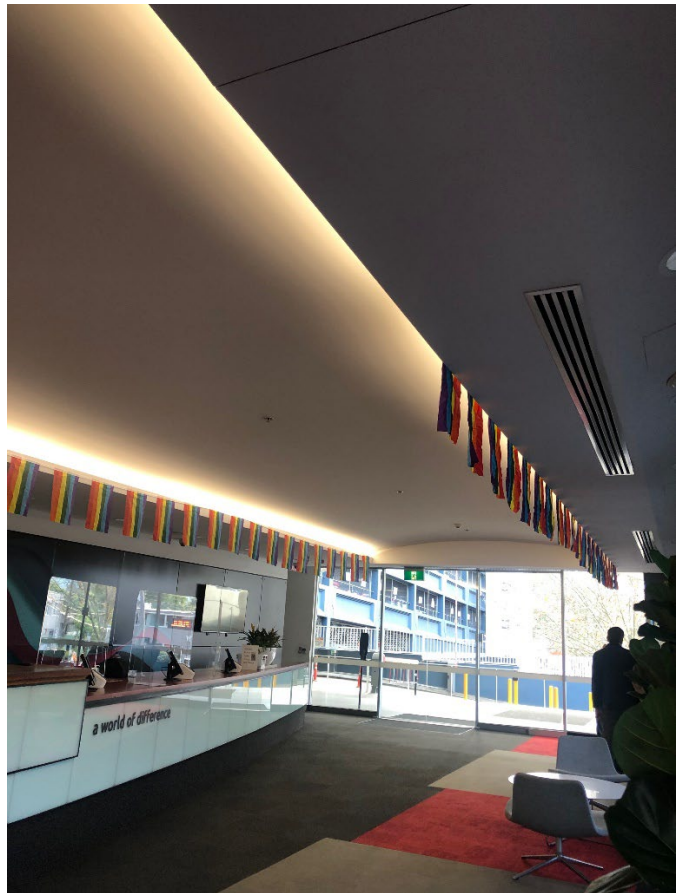
