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RBA has completed their Gender Affirmation policy, they designed it to be a living document and will be updated from time to time

ASIC has new Pride network chairs and they are getting up to speed. They did a session on Mardi Gras recently.

Austrac has approved their forward plan for their pride network, their main events are IDAHOBIT and the wear it purple day event this year.

ATO has gone to their SES for a new LGBTIQ champion and a new LGBTIQ Ally champion. They are also working on a IDAHOBIT day event virtually.

Treasury did not have a big update, but is scoping events for the year. Their major one is IDAHOBIT.

On the question of

APRA and ASIC has awards for values and they have recognised LGBTIQ. APRA records time. Top down from Treasury and RBA on spending time. And this time is viewed as important as "day job" work.

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
